- ### Top Tips for Travelling to Estuary Commerce Park by public transport
- Allow plenty of time for your journey
 - Obtain an up to date timetable from your local travel centre
 - Be aware that evening and Sunday services may differ from weekday services
 - Ensure that you have the sufficient fare for your journey or the appropriate travel pass
 - Purchasing a day rider ticket may be more convenient and cheaper than two single tickets.
 - Ask your bus driver for details.

How to get to Estuary Commerce Park



Rail Options

City Line service from Halewood Rail Station to Liverpool South Parkway which takes around 10 minutes, (Hourly service). Please see www.merseytravel.gov.uk for up to date rail timetables.

Northern Line service to Liverpool South Parkway from Liverpool Central & Moorfields Rail Stations, (frequent service). Northern Line trains run every 15 minutes to and from Liverpool South Parkway.

From Liverpool South Parkway, refer to bus section for connections to Estuary Commerce Park. There are 10 trains per hour between Liverpool South Parkway and Liverpool City Centre.

Buses From Liverpool South Parkway

80A from stand 5 (goes into Estuary Park, frequent service).

80 from stand 2 (stops at Speke Boulevard (Woodend Avenue), frequent service).

86A from stand 5 (stops in Estuary Park, frequent service).

188 & 288 stand 3 (Stops at Speke Road, two hourly service during peak).

Transfer to Estuary Commerce Park should take around 15 minutes.

Buses From Halewood/Belle Vale

LSP Circular (166,266)

Two hourly service from Halewood Ravenscourt Bus Facility & Belle Vale Bus Facility drops off on Speke Road.

Bus Route 883 - LJLA

Picks up from Halewood Ravenscourt Bus Facility Stop B, & Belle Vale Bus Facility Stop 2, drops off on Estuary Banks, hourly Monday – Friday service.

Buses to Estuary Commerce Park from Liverpool One Bus Station

180 From Stand 7, drops off on Estuary Banks, (Sundays Only).

186 From Stand 9, drops off on Estuary banks, (05.20am only).

500 From stand 8, drops off on Estuary Banks, (two per hour).

86A From stand 9, drops off on Estuary Banks, (frequent service).

80A From Stand 7, drops off on Dakota Drive, (frequent service).

82A from stand 8, drops off on Estuary Banks, (two per hour).

Transfer to Estuary Commerce Park should take around 40 minutes.
