WorkWise Wheels

WorkWise Travel Card
Up to a month's free public transport ticket is available to eligible applicants travelling to a new job.

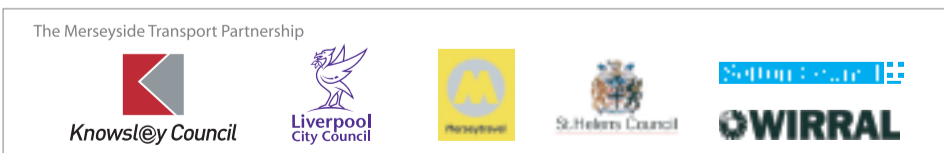
Need help with travelling to work?

Top Tips for travelling by public transport



- Allow plenty of time for your journey
- Obtain an up to date timetable from your local travel centre
- Be aware that evening and Sunday services may differ from weekday services
- Ensure that you have the sufficient fare for your journey or the appropriate travel pass
- Purchasing a day rider ticket may be more convenient and cheaper than two single tickets. Ask your bus driver for details

How to get to Skelmersdale from St Helens

Option 1

St Helens Bus Station; direct service to Skelmersdale

Hourly daytime service no changes needed, from stand 6, runs through Haresfinch, Carr Mill, Billinge and drops off at Skelmersdale Concourse. **Journey should take approximately 45 minutes.**

Option 2

St Helens – Orrell Post, then Orrell Post – Skelmersdale

From St Helens Bus Station

352 Service, from stand 6, St Helens to Orrell Post, frequent service, **journey should take approximately 30 minutes.**

From Orrell Post

375/385/395 service to Skelmersdale, from stop D, (on the opposite side of the road) frequent service, drops off at Skelmersdale Concourse, **journey should take around 20 minutes.**

Option 3 – Rail Option

St Helens Central Rail Station – Wigan Northwestern Rail Station, **train journey should take approximately 20 minutes.**

Then walk to Wigan Bus Station (Stop A). Walk should take less than 10 minutes.

From there take either 375/395/313 services to Skelmersdale Concourse, from Stop A. **Bus journey should take around 35 minutes.**

Option 4

St Helens Bus Station – Ormskirk, then Ormskirk – Skelmersdale

From St Helens

319 St Helens to Southport service, from stand 7 or 9, get off at Ormskirk, approximately hourly service, **journey takes around 30 minutes.**

39 St Helens to Ormskirk service, from stand 7, 07.58 or 08.58 only, **journey takes around 30 minutes.**

From Ormskirk

375/385/395 Southport to Wigan service, stops at Skelmersdale Concourse, hourly service, **journey should take around 30 minutes.**

Bus departure stands may differ from list. Always check up to date local timetable to determine what stand your bus departs from.
