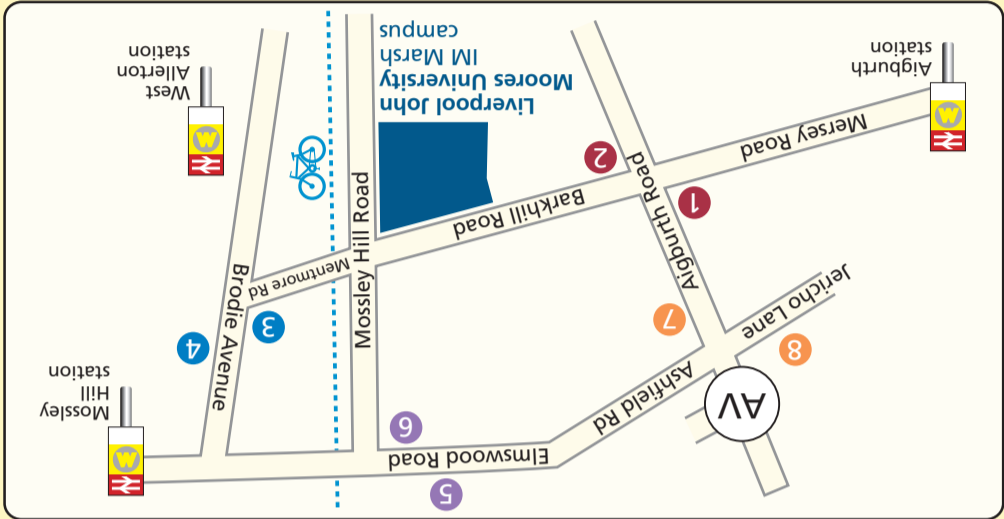
Merseytravel and Knowsley, Liverpool, Sefton, St Helens and Wirral Councils form the Local Transport Plan (LTP) partnership.

- 7 routes X1 to Runcorn
  - 8 routes X1 from Runcorn
- Bus stops at Aigburth Vale:**
- route 1 to / from City Centre / Broadgreen Hospital
  - route 4B to City Centre / Dingle
  - route 60 to Bootle
  - route 68, (168) to Broadgreen Hospital, (Bootle)
  - route 103 to City Centre / Waterloo

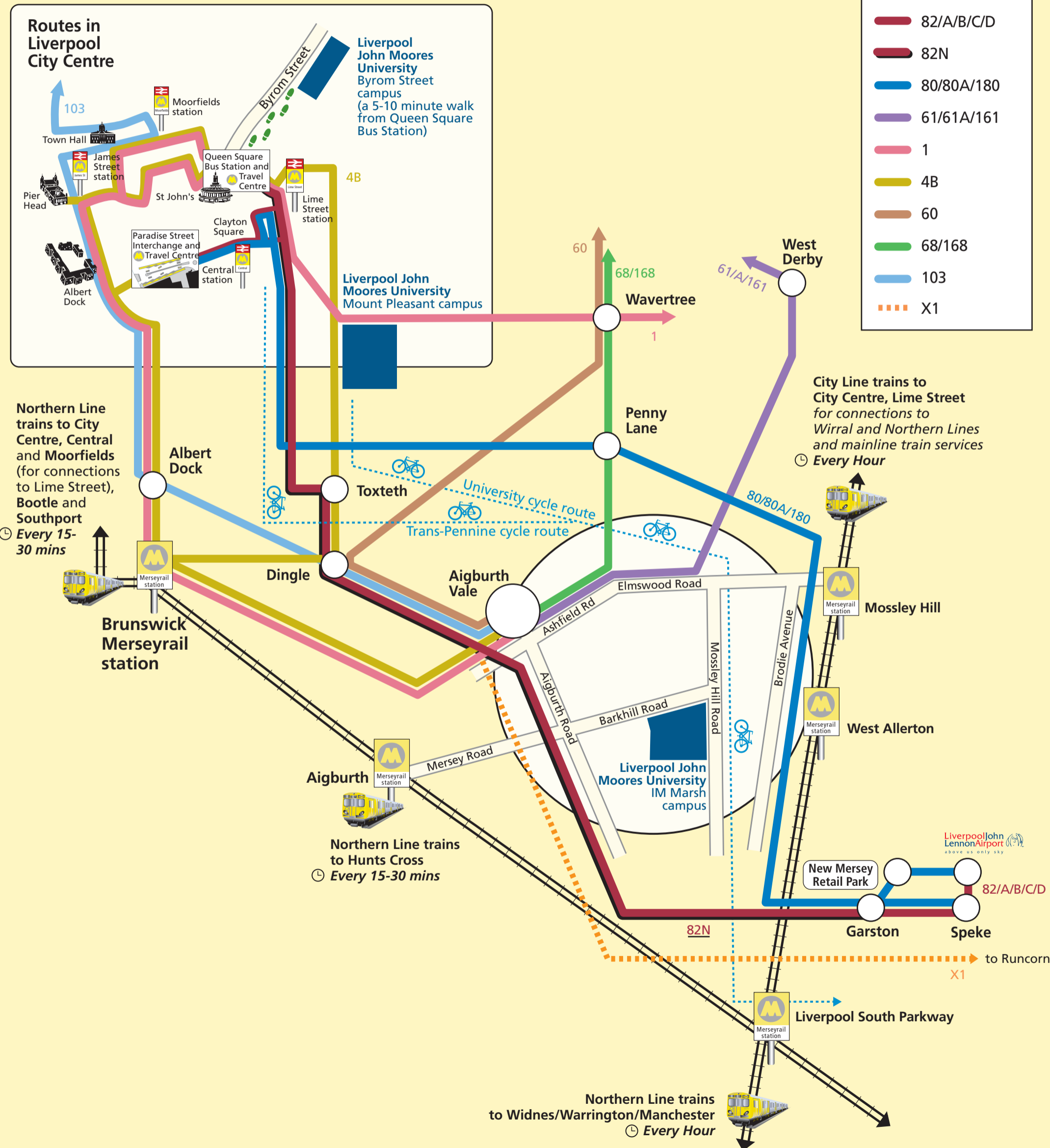


This Guide shows all the routes that serve the campus site. It gives details of how often buses run, and where the bus stops and rail stations are.
