



Greenbank Park offers a variety of activities for leisure including a children's playground, football pitches, fishing lake, as well as attractive mature trees and a conservation area. Pedestrian entrances are located on Greenbank Road, Greenbank Lane and via Gorsebank Road off Smithdown Road. There are several bus routes within a short walking distance. The Walled Garden is open from 10am to 5:45pm April to September and until 3:45pm October to March. The Walled Garden is closed on Bank Holidays. The park has achieved Green Flag status since 2005/06.



Set in over 100 hectares, **Sefton Park** continues to be Liverpool's most popular park and is home to the famous Palm House, a Grade II* listed Victorian conservatory.

Thanks to a successful multi-million pound bid to the Heritage Lottery Fund work is now complete on the rejuvenation of the lake and watercourses, restored monuments, rebuilt facilities and improvements to paths, bridges and new planting.

A large new playground has brought improved opportunities for children to exercise and play whilst close by the redesigned Café building has increased its size with improved facilities, a community room and a new Ranger Base for education and events. The new Boathouse Kiosk by the southern tip of the lake provides secure cycle parking.

Oterspool Park and Promenade provide panoramic views of the River Mersey and the Wirral Peninsula and are the perfect location for a family picnic, a healthy walk or just flying a kite. Replacement coastal walk railings, repaired footpaths, new seats and tables and a new Jericho Lane gateway have contributed to the Promenade recently gaining 'Green Flag' status. The Sitting Bull art installation, an outdoor gym fitness trail and a new children's play area adds to the fun. Just a 3 minute walk from Aigburth station.



Paxton's first park, **Princes Park** opened in 1843 as a private open space which did not become fully public until 1918. The Sunburst entrance gates were erected in 1858 and can still be seen. Angling, with a permit, is allowed on the lake plus there's a children's play area and outdoor gym. National Cycle Route 56 runs through its heart, with the city centre to the west and Sefton Park and Mossley Hill to the east.
