WorkWise TravelCard
 Up to a month's free public transport ticket is available to eligible applicants to travel to an interview or employment.

WorkWise Wheels
 A bicycle loan scheme with equipment is available to eligible applicants to travel to employment.

Scooter Commuter
 A six month loan of a 50cc scooter to enable eligible applicants to travel to employment is available complete with insurance, training, breakdown cover, provisional licence and personal protective equipment.

Give car sharing a try

Car sharing means what it says - two or more people making similar journeys travel together in the same car.

Someone else working at Whiston Hospital may live near you and work similar shifts - all you need to do is register the details of your journey on the Mersey Car Share Scheme and people with matching journeys will be found. You decide who to contact.
